# **Conditions for Participation**

The following basic requirements have to be considered for the participation in the programme:

Students must

- have completed at least the first year of Bachelor when they start their studyabroad mobility

- remain registered at their home institution

- agree on a course of study for their period abroad before the start of the mobility, summarized in an Erasmus+ Learning Agreement

# Selection criteria

The selection criteria for participants are defined by the sending higher education institution, in agreement with the receiving institution. The first criterion should be academic merit, but with equivalent academic level, preference should be assigned to students from less advantaged socio-economic backgrounds. The selection of participants, as well as the procedure for awarding them a grant, must be fair, transparent and documented.

Participants will receive all further information for a good, successful start in Cluj-Napoca after they have been nominated for a mobility at the University of Art and Design in Cluj-Napoca.

## Grant

Participants receive a mobility grant (individual financial support) for the period of studies, as well as a lump sum for travel costs.

The grant is as follows:

• Monthly subsistence grant of 750 EUR (meant to cover partially the expenses for board, meals, health insurance, local transport)

 Travel grant (lump sum corresponding to the distance range calculated by the Distance calculator platform of the European Commission) (EU distance calculator)

Details on financial support and payment arrangements to the participant will be set down in the Grant Agreement, the contract between the participant and the European Host University which has to be signed before the start of the mobility period. This document will be issued by the University of Art and Design in Cluj-Napoca after you have been selected for the Erasmus+ mobility.
